My daily routine

My normal working day begins very early at 5am and ends at 6pm.

~ Devotions with my wife.

~ Help feed the chickens. (My wife and I run a family poultry project which helps us to raise money for our three children's educational needs, such as school fees.)

~ Physical exercises in my small gym.

~ Bathing then take my son to school.

~ On my way to the office, I am involved in preaching and ministry in the market place e.g. industries, factories, schools and police officers on parade.

~ Check my emails from countries in different time zones, acknowledge or respond accordingly before having team devotions.

~ Respond to assignments, reports and requests from the AE Zimbabwe Team, AEI, the Communications Department, Support Offices, Board, Accountants, Auditors, Stakeholders and the bank. I also ensure my diary and calendar of events are updated with meeting targets and deadlines.

~ Typically, I work about 9 hours per day and about 47.5 hours per week. It's important to be available to support my team and the International team 24/7, even during holidays!

On Team Leadership:

Being the AEEZ team leader is a complex role, and keeps me dependent on God every day. The public role of a Team Leader, in big evangelistic outreaches is very important. There are interactions with politicians, diplomats, judiciary, members of parliament, and captains of industries. There are press conferences and press releases to attend and prepare, and people to show around the country. Praise God for these opportunities!
